## ISSUES ENCOUNTERED

**Section 4.(K1) of RA 11469: Goods which may include personal protective equipment such as gloves, masks, gowns face shields , surgical equipment and supplies, among others.**

**Section 4.(K2) of RA 11469: Goods and Services for social amelioration measures in favor of affected communities.**

1. Social amelioration by the Permit/Contract Holders through purchasing of goods – the host community/ies requested permit/contract holders to purchase and personally deliver the goods to the respective households within the community/ies since some household complained that the barangay officials are selective, and some do not receive their share.
2. The LGU requested for cash assistance - Permit/Contract holders are hesitant to give/provide cash assistance to the concerned LGU since there will be difficulty in the accounting/auditing of goods that were purchased by the LGU. Further, there are also feedbacks from the residents of the community that not all residents received their share/assistance.
3. Withdrawal of big amount of money from the banks by the Permit/Contract Holders are not possible this time since withdrawal of money are done through ATMs.
4. Purchase of goods cannot be delivered immediately to the concerned LGU since all potential areas for purchasing are locked down.
